

Fast Forward to College (▶▶FWD): 30 Minutes at a Time

Fast Forward to College (▶▶FWD) is a fully sequenced set of 30 interactive, easy to implement lessons and activities for grades Kindergarten through 5th grade. They are meant to be used in school, after school or community settings to foster college and career readiness. They are aligned to Common Core, ELD and Social Emotional Learning competencies. Each theme contains five lessons that build on each other throughout the year*. Each lesson is designed to work within a grade level span (K-2 and 3-5) and increase in sophistication and rigor each year. These elementary school lessons set the foundation for middle and high school Fast Forward to College lessons, completing a scope and sequence for Kindergarten through 12th grade based on the college-going framework of college aspirations, college knowledge and college planning.
